2. In the first paragraph of Document 2, Marx charges that England has “broken down the entire framework of Indian society.” In his reference to “British steam and science” he begins to explain his reasoning. Read the third paragraph carefully to answer the question: How, according to Marx, has the destruction of traditional Indian society come about?
