## **Central Questions**:

- 1. Your editorial must include a minimum of 4 paragraphs as described below.
- 2. Your editorial should use persuasive language and should be written to the English people.
- 3. Your editorial should be written in the 1<sup>st</sup> person, plural tense "we".

# **Editorial Format**:

Paragraph I:

Take a clear position on the central questions.

Paragraph II:

Support your position with historical evidence.

### Paragraph III:

- A: Acknowledge the arguments of your opponents.
- B: Respond to your opponents' arguments.

### Paragraph IV:

Provide a conclusion that summarizes your position.
