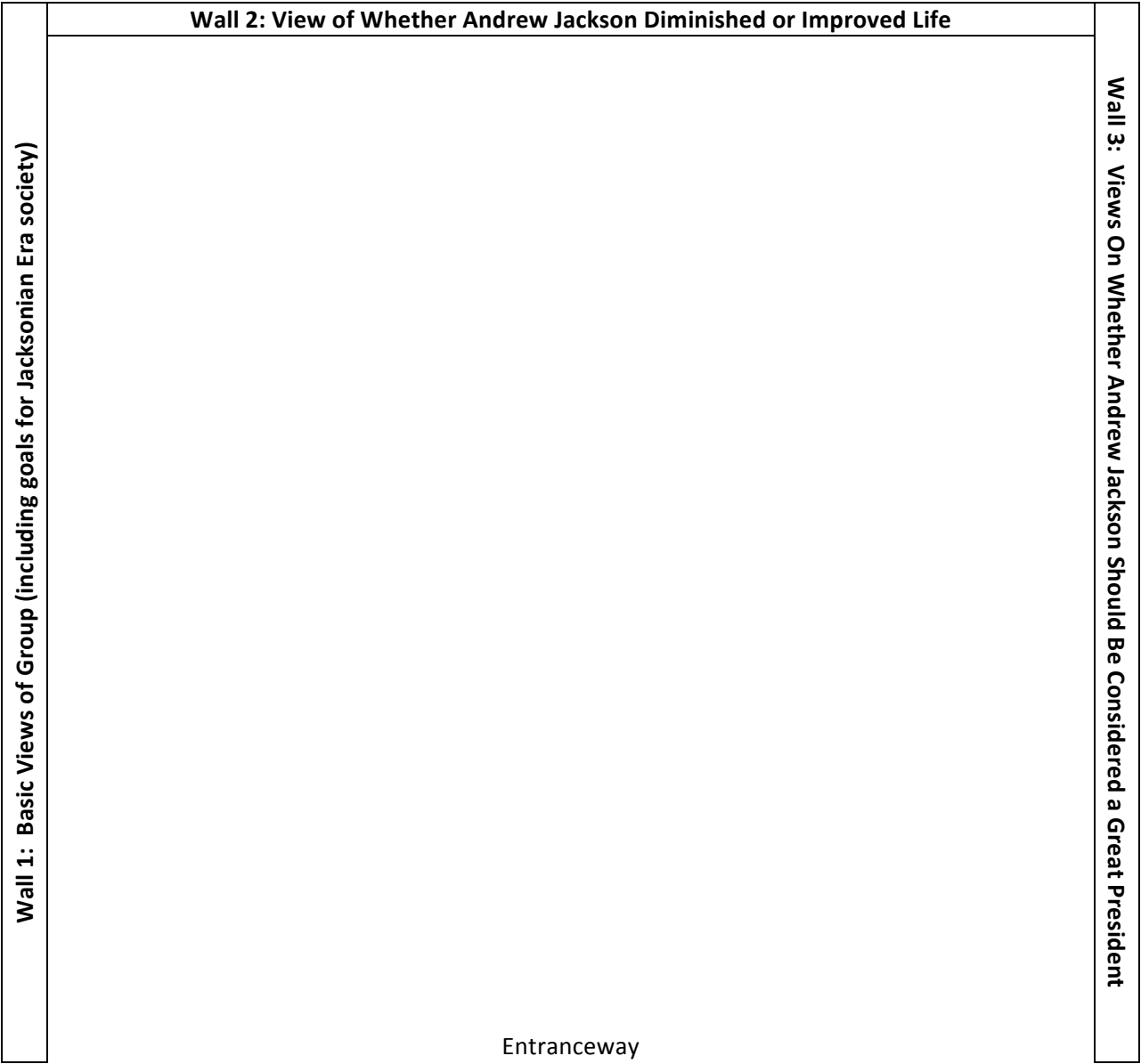


**Jacksonian Era Museum Exhibit Layout**
