

Sentencing Memorandum

Commonwealth v. Henderson (1986)

Psychiatric Evaluation Summary:

The defendant displays characteristics consistent with the schizophrenia, including the following symptoms:

- Auditory hallucinations
- Disorganized thought patterns.

There is also evidence of long term alcohol dependence and learning disability.

Henderson exhibits below-average intelligence (Full Scale IQ: 73).

It is recommended that he receive ongoing psychological evaluation and treatment.
