Incident Overview

Jack Gentry was shot during an armed robbery. He was found on the ground with a gunshot wound. Gentry was pronounced dead on scene.

Blood Pattern Analysis

- Blood Pattern Analysis shows that the victim was likely laying face-up when he was shot.

Gunshot Trajectory Analysis

- Due to the angle of the gunshot, the weapon was fired at a steep downward angle from directly over Gentry.

Blood Spatter Pattern

- Blood spatter patterns show no evidence of defensive struggle.

Findings

- Due to the nature of the analysis, findings suggest that Gentry was shot execution style with no defense from an assailant standing over him.
